



VHA Policy 1.4: Structure of VHA and Affiliated Organizations

Authorization: Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of The Villages Homeowners Advocates, Inc. (VHA) and VHA Helping Hands, Inc. (VHA-HH).

The VHA “Family”: The VHA family of affiliated organizations includes the two 501(c)3 not-for-profit corporations listed above. Each has a somewhat different mission while both have the vision “keeping the dream alive” for residents of The Villages, Florida.

Each of the corporations has its own Board of Directors, Officers, Bylaws, Policies & Procedures.

Sole Member: The VHA, Inc., as represented by its Board of Directors, is the Sole Member of VHA Helping Hands, Inc. Its role is spelled out in the VHA-HH Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws. The President of The VHA, Inc., or his/her named substitute, represents the Sole Member on the Board of Directors of VHA-HH.

Organization Chart of The VHA, Inc.: The President and Executive Vice President of the Villages Homeowners Advocates, Inc., are elected by the Board of Directors to one-year terms. Both are subject to 5-term limits. Other officers, directors, and representatives are appointed by their immediate superiors. The structure is defined in the Bylaws of The VHA.
