THE VHA THIRD QUARTER REPORT 2020

he third quarter of 2020 saw a reduction in membership dues collected from the same period in 2019. We went from collecting \$43,330 in 2019 to \$35,944 for the same period in 2020, resulting in a difference of 17% or \$7,386 in less dues collected. A percentage of this result is due to the fact that external forces caused by the pandemic made us unable to recruit new members. We also have to be aware that a certain percentage of this loss can be contributed to a reduction of renewals.

The gross profit for the third quarter of 2020 is \$32,552 (less Hoedown) compared to \$49,016 for the same period in 2019. The reduced income for 2020 is also partially due to the Golf Cart Safety program being put on hold and the Administrative Service Agreement being adjusted, along with the reduced membership

Expenses for the period were \$59,187 for 2019 and 49,559 for 2020 (less Hoedown and Contributions). The expense for The Voice is \$3,088 less in 2020 than it was in 2019. Other savings were in Professional Fees and Golf Cart Safety Presentations

Net Income for the 2020 third quarter is a loss of \$9,328 as compared to a loss of \$10,171 for the same period in 2019.
